SENIOR PRTRAITS MUST HAVES - Instructions:

- Be taken by a professional photographer. Please contact Mr. Stark if you run into special circumstances.
- Schedule your photoshoot as early as possible. Preferably during the Summer or as school begins.
- Vertical shots only. <u>NO PETS ALLOWED IN THE SHOT!</u>
- Digital Photos only. All pictures should be 300 dpi/ppi with a photo size no less than 750x1050.
- Photo must be submitted in <u>IPEG</u> format only.

SENIOR PORTRAIT DRESS CODE: Student & Parent Instructions

- NO PETS ALLOWED IN THE SHOT! JUST YOU! [Reserve that for your Senior Ads]
- No Shorts! Seniors may wear dark jeans (No rips, tears, or frays of any kind). The school reserves the right to reject photos!
- No bare shoulders, cut-outs in sleeves, or excessively low cleavage!
- No t-shirts, no tank tops, or spaghetti straps.
- No hats of any kind. This goes for both boys and girls.
- Gentleman Nice <u>collared</u> shirt. (No earrings please.)
- Ladies Nice blouse or full-length dress (for full length shots). Nothing low-cut or formfitting please.
- Both No tattoos showing, inappropriate dyed hair, inappropriate haircuts/styles, or facial piercings.
- Gentlemen, ensure you are clean shaven—NO MUSTACHES OR BEARDS—this is a daily item for dresscode checks, so please comply with this rule.

- Please exercise good judgement and common sense. This is the final picture of you on record, and it will be published in the Yearbook please represent the core values of our Catholic School as a Noble Knight.
